




Funding

- Clean Ohio Trails Fund grant – applied for in 2021 and 2022. We have been awarded the grant as of June 2023.
 - Assistance requested: \$500,000
 - Total estimated project costs at time of application: \$1.2 million
- Cuyahoga County Community Development ARPA grant received in 2022 for \$250,000.
- Other funding sources will continue to be pursued for other project costs.
- City to fund the remaining costs.



Lander Road Walking Path Access



Shaker Blvd. Walking Path Access



South Woodland Road Walking Path Access


